Qualifications:

1. Applicants do not hold Thai citizenship and have completed high school or passed an equivalent high school standard test or be currently in their final year of high school (Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British system). The equivalency of high school qualifications shall observe the following criteria:

British education system

- Applicants shall have GCE 'A' Level results in 3 subjects, with grades A*-E; or
- Applicants shall have Cambridge Pre-U results in 3 subjects, scoring at least M1 or D1-D3 in each subject.

American/Canadian system

- Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2017 shall have GED results in 5 subjects, scoring at least 410 in each subject and scoring at least 2,250 for total score.
- Applicants taking the GED tests since May 2017 BE onwards shall have total score 660 GED and at least 145 in each subject.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Programs

- Applicants who graduated from overseas shall have an IB Diploma: that is; having a total score of no less than 24 points from 5 subjects and 1 elective subject, and shall have passed the evaluation on Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Action & Service (CAS) under the criteria of International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO); or
- Applicants have IB Diploma Course Results (IBCR) of at least 5 different subjects and receiving no lower than Grade 3 in each subject.

International programs from other countries outside the system mentioned above

Please check the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications announced on 21 April 2563 BE



If your high school certificate is not in the list above, you must submit the equivalency certificate (GCE/GED/IB) as prove of your education.

****Noted: Applicants from Myanmar must submit GED****

2. Applicants who expected to graduate or haven't received a high school certificate, or an equivalent by the time of the **admission. The applicants can submit the certificate within July.**

Application Requirements:

1. An equivalent high school standard test as mentioned in the qualifications above

1. Language Proficiency Test (choose only 1 from below)

- TOEFL = (iBT) 65 OR
- IELTS = 6.0 OR
- TU-GET Score = (PBT) 500 OR
(CBT) 74 OR
- SAT = (Evidence Based Reading and Writing) 400

Documents Required:

1. TISR Application form
2. A certified copy of High School Certificate or Diploma or any other equivalent qualification as authorized by the respective country's Ministry of Education or other assigned government agency, which must be translated to English, if issued in any other language and be confirmed by their own government's appropriate Ministry or Embassy or issued in English by the school that issued the graduation record, diploma, or transcript. (For GED, applicants must submit before 29th April 2024).
3. A certified copy of High School Transcripts (Translated to English and get certified by their own Embassy or issued in English by their high school or equivalent graduated school).
4. A certified copy of your passport
5. A certified copy of an English Proficiency Test (as mentioned in the application requirements) - must not be older than 2 years counting from the examination date to the new student registration date.

****Important:**

1. The applicants must submit all the required documents as scheduled. Should an applicant fail to submit the evidence by the deadlines, the applicant shall be disqualified.
2. The applicants must be qualified according to the application announcement. Should the university find that an applicant is disqualified afterward, the applicant will not be accepted into the program.
