Prerequisites

- 1 Must be a full-time undergraduate student at an ACP Consortium member university. Any major is acceptable.
- 2 Must have a grade point average of at least 2.3 out of 3.00 **based on the calculation method specified by JASSO.**
- 3 Must be Fluent in English (all the lectures are delivered in English)

How to apply

Applicants should submit a complete set of application documents to the office of the university to which they belong. Designated application forms are sent to each university office.

Each university will select recommenders. Only the documents of recommenders selected by each university will be sent to KUISS.

Participation Fees

JPY 130,000

Include: accommodation, breakfast, transport during the program

Exclude: transport between your home and Kansai International Airport, travel insurance, lunch & dinner

Scholarship

Number of scholarship recipients: 10
Stipend amount: JPY 80,000

By becoming a recipient of this scholarship, the program participation fee is effectively reduced to JPY 50,000
