Principles governing academic writing for scholarly dissemination, extending from scholarly papers to theses and dissertations. Advanced skills and comprehensive understanding necessary for achieving proficiency in high-level academic writing in English.
EG810	Current Trends in English Language Studies	3	Current trends in the subdisciplines of English language studies: literary and cultural studies, creative writing, media and digital studies, rhetoric and composition, applied linguistics, and digital humanities.
EG830	Global Englishes	3	The roles and characteristics of Global Englishes in contemporary society, which is increasingly becoming a multilingual and multicultural society; studies revolving around key concepts in Global Englishes such as the English language ideology, the ownership of English and native-speakerism; the identity of English users; World Englishes and emerging paradigms e.g., English as a Lingua Franca, translanguaging, and English-medium instruction.

EG706	English Pronunciation and Speaking	3	Key principles of English pronunciation and speaking in a globalized era. Recent research studies on the learning and teaching of pronunciation and speaking. Development of fluency and accuracy in spoken discourse at the word, sentential, and discourse levels. Analysis of the recent goals of speaking: intelligibility, comprehensibility, and acceptability. Strategies for integrating artificial intelligence into classroom teaching.
EG716	English Language Teaching Methods	3	Contemporary English language teaching methodologies, their theoretical underpinnings, and practical applications. Design of effective learning experiences for diverse learners through engaging in interactive activities, developing lesson plans, and exploring research-based practices.
EG717	Digital Literacies in Language Learning	3	Theories, research, and practice in digital literacy with an emphasis on the use of digital tools in language learning. Analysis of their roles in the critical perspectives.
EG718	Language Assessment	3	Key concepts, principles and practices of language testing and assessment within contemporary language teaching and learning, design and construction of testing and assessment tools appropriate to learning settings, and issues and trends in language testing and assessment.

EG719	Corpus Linguistics in English Language Studies	3	General concepts about corpus linguistics. A survey of corpus resources and corpus analysis tools. Corpus approaches to the analysis of the English language. Classroom applications of corpus studies and corpus-informed research on the topics related to English language studies.
EG726	English for Specific Purposes	3	Principles of English for Specific Purposes (ESP) and its associated branches, theories, evolution, research pertinent to critical ESP and such branches, applications in course and curriculum development, including need analysis, syllabus creation, ESP teaching methodologies focusing on language skills, content, and their integration, learning materials development, assessment strategies, and ESP implementation in specialized fields.
EG727	Discourse Analysis in English Language Contexts	3	Fundamental concepts, methodologies, frameworks, analytical tools, and objectives that are used in discourse analysis of the English language. Understanding of language as a social semiotic practice and examination of how discourse can be used to construe and reflect ideologies, identities, hegemonic practices, and power dynamics within various social and institutional contexts.
EG736	Dynamics of Intercultural Communication in the Professional Sphere	3	Interplay between language and culture, language and social interactions, dimensions of intercultural communication. Current theories and research in intercultural communication, and strategic application of knowledge in professional contexts of an evolving world emphasising heightened intercultural sensitivity.
EG737	Intercultural Communication for Translators and Interpreters	3	Interdisciplinary research skills and theoretical understanding for further research in interpreting studies—encompassing the shared areas among translation, interpretation, and intercultural communication domains, such as foreignisation and domestication strategies, Cultural Dimensionality, and Intercultural Communicative Competence Models.
EG738	Intercultural Pragmatics in the Digital Era	3	Principles, theories, and challenges in cross-cultural and intercultural pragmatics from linguistics and communication studies perspectives. Interdisciplinary and innovative approaches as well as practical applications. Critical analysis of authentic human interactions across cultures through various traditional and digital (interactive) platforms.
EG756	Film and Fiction in the Contemporary World	3	Topics within contemporary works via films and fictions. Analysis of storytelling and influence of selected texts to unveil the hidden social and cultural implications. Role of media and literature in fostering creativity and communication.
