Qualifications

1. Criteria

- Non-Thai Nationality and have no residence in Thailand.
- Applicants must have completed high school Grade 12 or the equivalent.
- Applicants who use General Education Development (GED) must have completed GED on the following conditions;
 - Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2017 shall have GED results in 5 subjects, scoring at least 410 in each subject and at least 2,250 for a total score.
 - Applicants taking the GED tests since May 2017 BE onwards shall have GED results in 4 subjects, scoring at least 145 in each subject.
 - Applicants who expected to graduate or haven't received a high school certificate, or an equivalent by the time of the admission. The applicants can submit the certificate within July or the date set by the university.

Requirement:

1. GPAX Not Determined

2. Language Proficiency Test

SAT EBRW = Minimum score 450

TOEFL = Minimum score 80

IELTS = Minimum score 6.5

TU-GETS = Minimum score 550

Duolingo English Test = Minimum score 120

Gaokao English = Minimum Score 120

3. Other Specific Eligibility Criteria -

TISR Test:

- 1.Math (Science) = Minimum score 30
- 2.English Communication = Minimum score 65

Documents Required:

1. High School Certificate or Diploma or any other equivalent qualification as authorized by the respective country's Ministry of Education or other assigned government agency, which must be translated to English, if issued in any other language and be confirmed by their own government's appropriate Ministry or Embassy or issued in English by the school that issued the graduation record, diploma, or transcript. (For GED, applicants can submit before August 2025)
2. High School Transcripts (Translated to English and certified by their own Embassy or issued in English by their high school or equivalent graduated school.
3. Passport for foreign applicants and one copy of Identification Card and residence registration for Thai students.
4. Resume
