Qualification:

1. Non-Thai Nationality and MUST NOT HAVE any permanent residence in Thailand.
2. Applicants must have completed high school Grade 12 or the equivalent.
3. Others: Applicants must submit proof of education to the faculty in accordance with the education qualification equivalency announced by the Ministry of Education.

British education system

- Applicants shall have GCE 'A' Level results in 3 subjects, with grades A*-E; or
- Applicants shall have Cambridge Pre-U results in 3 subjects, scoring at least M1 or D1-D3 in each subject.

American/Canadian system

Applicants must complete General Education Development (GED).

- Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2017 shall have GED results in 5 subjects, scoring at least 410 in each subject.
- Applicants taking the GED tests since May 2017 shall have total score 660 and at least 145 points on each subject.

**Applicants taking the GED tests must submit the score before the written exam date. **

International Baccalaureate (IB) Programs

- Applicants who graduated from overseas shall have an IB Diploma: that is; having a total score of no less than 24 points from 5 subjects and 1 elective subject, and shall have passed the evaluation on Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and Creativity, Action & Service (CAS) under the criteria of International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO); or
- Applicants have IB Diploma Course Results (IBCR) of at least 5 different subjects and receiving no lower than Grade 3 in each subject.

International programs from other countries outside the system mentioned above, please check the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications announced on 21 April 2563 BE

- Applicants who expected to graduate or haven't received a high school certificate, or an equivalent by the time of the admission. The applicants can submit the certificate within July.

Selection Method:

- 1. Faculty's tests
- 2. Interview

Documents Required:

- 1. A copy of your passport (with your signature)
- 2. A copy of high school certificate or equivalency certificate (with your signature) or GED certificate if your high school certificate is not in the list of the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications.
OR A copy of letter confirming your student status issued within 3 months (for applicants currently studying in Grade 12 only)
- 3. A copy of high school transcript (with your signature) or GED Transcript if your high school is not in the list of the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications.
- 4. A copy of an English Proficiency Test (with your signature) - must not be older than 2 years counting from the examination date to the new student registration date.

Remarks:

- 1. Please check the equivalency of overseas qualifications from the Ministry of Education's Announcement on Equivalency of Overseas Qualifications.



If your high school certificate is not in the list above, you must submit the equivalency certificate (GCE/GED/IB) as prove of your education.

2. The faculty requires you to translate foreign-language documents into English. The applicant must submit both an original copy of the document and a certified English translation.

3. The applicants must be qualified according to the application announcement. Should the university find that an applicant is disqualified afterward, the applicant will not be accepted into the program.
