3. Applicants must complete General Education Development (GED). Applicants taking the GED tests before May 2017 shall have GED results in 5 subjects, scoring at least 410 in each subject. Applicants taking the GED tests since May 2017 BE onwards shall have GED results in 4 subjects, scoring at least 145 in each subject.
4. Applicants who expected to graduate or haven't received a high school certificate, or an equivalent by the time of the admission. The applicants can submit the certificate within July or within the date set by the university.
